

Dear Seaton Neighbours,

PLEASE USE THE SEATON COMMUNITY PRESCRIPTION COLLECTION SCHEME DURING COVID 19

Rutland County Council and the Uppingham Surgery have asked us to help minimise the number of people visiting the Surgery to collect prescriptions.

Doing this will help the pharmacy plan and manage its workload; reduce the number of unnecessary journeys; and, thus help reduce the risk of spreading Covid 19.

All residents are therefore requested use the Seaton Good Neighbour collection service, whatever your circumstances.

What do you need to do?

- * Order your medication in the usual way. Make sure you allow at least 72 hours (3 days) for repeat prescriptions.
- * Contact the Seaton Good Neighbour group to arrange collection either by email to seatonrutland@gmail.com or text on [07506 744288](tel:07506744288).
- * Tell us your name/phone number/address.
- * Tell us the dates your medication will be 'ready by' and 'needed by' (so we can arrange group collections whenever possible).
- * Give us as much advanced notice as possible.

What will we do?

- * We will confirm we have received your request.
- * We will agree when your medication will be collected.
- * We will let you know when we are about to deliver your medicine to your door.

* We will collect any urgent requests, or medication required on the day they are prescribed, on the same day.

Any problems, please call us. And, remember: if we Stay at Home, we can Help the NHS, and Help Save Lives.
